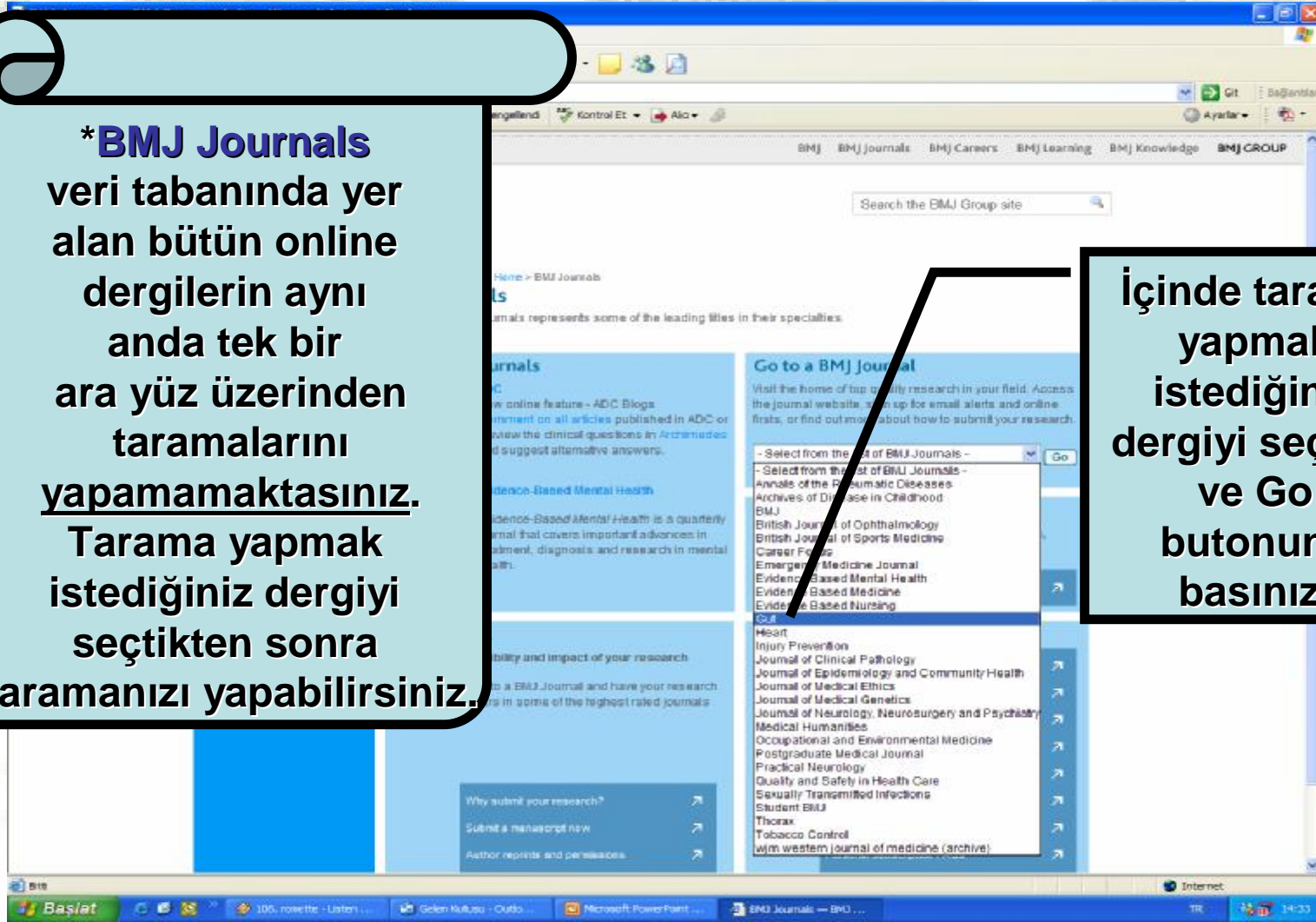

**Abstract**  
Background and aims—Whether healthcare workers have an increased prevalence of hepatitis C virus infection as a result of exposure to patient's blood and body fluids is controversial. This study assesses the prevalence of hepatitis C virus infection in healthcare workers, and its relation to the performance of exposure prone procedures and duration of occupational exposure, allowing an estimate to be made of the incidence of occupationally acquired hepatitis C infection among medical staff.

**Methods**—In this anonymous retrospective cohort study, we estimated the prevalence of hepatitis C infection in 664 healthcare workers. ELISA-3 testing was performed on pools of five sera collected during immunisation against hepatitis B. Healthcare workers were arranged into five occupational groups, according to the degree of patient exposure, and three age bands (0-19 years, 20-29 years, 30-64 years).

**Results**—Prevalence of antibodies to hepatitis C was 0.28% (20/664), comparable in all occupational groups (p=0.54) and unrelated to duration of potential exposure. Assuming that all detected



**GASTROINTESTINAL CANCER**

Background: The role of positron emission tomography with the glucose analogue [<sup>18</sup>F]fluoro-2-deoxy-D-glucose (FDG-PET) in the initial staging of disease in patients with primary colorectal cancer (CRC) has not been adequately assessed.

Aims: To evaluate the additional value of FDG-PET as a staging modality, complementary to routine multidetector row computed tomography (MDCT) in patients with CRC.

Methods: Forty four patients with CRC underwent preoperative MDCT and FDG-PET. The accuracy of interoperative macroscopic staging was also investigated and compared with histopathological diagnosis. All FDG-PET images were evaluated with respect to detectability of the primary tumour, lymph node involvement, and distant metastases. Both MDCT and FDG-PET diagnosis and treatment plan were compared with surgical and histopathological results.

Results: Thirty seven patients underwent surgery. Tumour detection rate was 95% (42/44) for MDCT, 100% (44/44) for FDG-PET, and 100% (37/37) for interoperative macroscopic diagnosis. Pathological diagnosis of T factor was T1 in five, T2 in four, T3 in 24, and T4 in four cases. Concordance with pathological findings of T factor was 57% (21/37) for MDCT and 62% (23/37) for macroscopic diagnosis. Lymph node involvement was pathologically positive in 19 cases. Regarding T factor, overall accuracy was 62% (23/37) for MDCT, 59% (22/37) for FDG-PET, and 70% (26/37) for macroscopic diagnosis. For all 44 patients, FDG-PET findings resulted in treatment changes in only one (2%) patient.

Conclusions: FDG-PET is not superior to routine MDCT in the initial staging of primary CRC.

Analysis of suspected serious adverse reactions reported to the Committee on Safety of Medicines in the UK in 1991-1998. Adverse effect profiles were categorized for intestinal neoplasia, serious skin reactions, hepatitis and hepatic failure, and blood dyscrasias. Reports were collated using prescribing data from the Department of Health and compared for mesalazine and sulphasalazine. Further analysis was undertaken for sulphasalazine according to disease location (inflammatory bowel disease or rheumatoid arthritis).
  - Results: A total of 2.7 million prescriptions were dispensed for sulphasalazine compared with 2.1 million for mesalazine. Intestinal neoplasia was only described for mesalazine, with 11.1 reports per million prescriptions compared with sulphasalazine (1.1 per million prescriptions) (odds ratio (OR) 7.0, confidence interval (CI) 2.4-21.6; p<0.001). There were no reports of serious skin disorders in patients prescribed sulphasalazine for inflammatory bowel disease. Blood dyscrasias were reported significantly more often in patients receiving sulphasalazine for rheumatoid arthritis than for inflammatory bowel disease (OR 5.31, 95% CI 2.6-11.0; p<0.001), and there was a similar trend for hepatic disorders.
  - Conclusions: Spontaneous reports suggest that within the five sets of disorders considered, there is evidence to indicate a safety advantage of mesalazine over sulphasalazine in the treatment of inflammatory bowel disease. Toxicity and intestinal neoplasia appear significantly more common with mesalazine, and advice on renal monitoring in patients who receive mesalazine may be warranted.


